

Call for AS Workshops

The Academy of Sociology seeks to co-fund up to two workshops or smaller conferences organized by AS members with 500-2000 EUR per year. Funding will be provided for conferences and workshops covering methodological, theoretical or practical issues pertinent to the field of empirical-analytical sociology. In addition to contents, we also evaluate proposed workshops and conferences on the basis of how well they meet the extended goals of the Academy. These goals are, e.g., the promotion of good scientific practice, replication & reproduction, interdisciplinarity, gender equality, internationality and the promotion of young researchers in empirical-analytical research.

All members of the Academy of Sociology are eligible to apply, regardless of career stage. In addition to the applying Academy member, individuals who are not members of the Academy are welcome to act as co-organizers of the event.

Applicants for a grant should submit the following:

- Summary of the objectives and expected results of the workshop (approximately 500 words)
- Budget plan detailing the costs to be covered and information about co-funding if applicable
- Preliminary call for papers and dissemination strategy to inform potential participants

Applications for funding of events in the 2019 calendar year should be sent to **workshop@akademie-soziologie.de** by **31 October 2018**.

Applications are reviewed and selected for funding by the Board of the Academy of Sociology. Applicants will generally be informed within four weeks of the deadline (end of November 2018) whether their application was successful.

Please note that the Board reserves the right to fund less than two workshops in a year if not enough suitable applications are received. Remaining funds from a previous funding period can be spent on additional grants in the next funding period.

After the event, we ask grantees to submit a short report on what has been achieved and on expected outcomes of the event (e.g. publication of a special issue, funding application, future cooperation of participants). This short report should contain about 1-2 pages and will be published in our AS-newsletter.
